

# Presentation Guidelines

- You can present **on your own** or choose to **work with 1 or 2 other people** who have the same topic

# Length

- 3-5 minutes (for each group member)
- at least 3 slides (for each group member)

Practice your presentations to make sure you meet the length requirements.

# Required Multimedia

- 1 thematic map
- 1 piece of artwork
- 1-2 relevant photos
- Integrate these throughout the presentation to keep it interesting. Don't put them all at the beginning or end.

# Information

- Attention Grabber
- Introduction to your topic
- Explanation of why this topic is important / why we should care about it.
- Your thesis statement (your evaluation/proposed solution)
- At least 2 CDs that back up your argument
- Explanation/analysis of the map
- Explanation/analysis of the artwork
- Explanation/analysis of the photo(s)

# Presentation

The explanations and analysis should **not** be written on the slides. You should be presenting them – this is an **oral presentation**.

# Research

- The CDs, artwork, thematic maps, thesis statements, and explanations should all be coming from the **research** you've done so far and your **essay**.
- You might need to do a little additional research to turn your work into a presentation, but it should be based on what you've already done.
